# **FINAL APPROACH: Get Things Going**

- 1. Final crew consultation ('anybody know something I should know?')
- 2. Survey surrounding area (debris, bystanders, victims, occupants, etc.)
- 3. Address water supply (if smoke showing, multiple callers, etc.)
- 4. Housekeeping stuff (police for traffic, utility company, investigator, etc.)
- 5. Confirm that dispatched address/occupancy is correct ('approaching 123 Main Street').

### **BOX ONE: Arrival Report**

- 1. Occupancy & Showing
- 2. Designate Side-Alpha
- 3. Capture Responding Units
- 4. Initiate Command
- 5. Investigation Mode

Psshhh... Airbrake is your cue!

# **BOX TWO: Focused Strategy**

- 1. Team sets the table
- 2. Talk to Somebody
- 3. List Big Six
- 4. Identify Hazards
- 5. Determine Value-Time-Size (V-T-S)

Ssshhh... Leave me alone!



### **BOX THREE: Update Report**

- 1. Building Snapshot
- 2. Big Six Report
- 3. Update the Mode (call the play)
- 4. Draft Initial Action Plan (IAP)
- 5. Assign IAP Objectives

#### **BOX FOUR: Establish Command Post**

- 1. Name & Locate
- 2. Tactical Accountability
- 3. Coordinate Objectives
- 4. Obtain Status Reports
- 5. Strategy, Resources, & Risk

10-minute V-T-S updates!

#### **COMMAND POST: Situational Awareness**

- 1. Command Caveat #1: If you need something and it is not there and available it's too late.
- 2. Ongoing evaluation of conditions, action plan, & mode
- 3. Ongoing value-time-size determination
- 4. Appropriate strategic & tactical adjustments
- 5. Broadcast Command Post benchmarks
